

CONTRACT FOR IT TECHNICAL SERVICES 2025-26

This agreement, entered this 1st day of July 2025, by and between Meeker and Wright Special Education Cooperative, #938 (MAWSECO) and Howard Lake-Waverly-Winsted ISD #2687 (HLWW District) witnesses that:

WHEREAS, MAWSECO has determined that it is necessary to retain the services of a qualified IT Technical Services staff to provide technical support services for the following:

WHEREAS HLWW District staff is duly qualified to perform these services.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. HLWW District staff shall provide the services necessary to meet the objectives stated above.
2. HLWW District staff shall provide services at the sites listed above.
3. The IT Technical Services will be funded from federal 108-446 funds and district local general education funds.
4. HLWW District will provide technical service for the contracted sum of \$80,000 per year. Service will include all facets of MAWSECO technology including devices, hardware, software, etc. It may also include, as agreed upon, training for MAWSECO staff. In consultation with HLWW staff, budget recommendations may be made but the final budget approval for MAWSECO technology remains with MAWSECO administration.
5. If emergency technical services are needed that will require extra hours more than normal services, the parties will mutually agree upon a separate agreement for payment of the additional time spent, or services may require a contracted service to complete the work, in which case MAWSECO shall pay for all expenses from the outside vendor.
6. HLWW District shall maintain appropriate liability coverage commensurate with the services provided.
7. On a quarterly basis, HLWW District Staff shall compile a time study of the three previous months service, determining an estimate of direct, indirect, and email/phone correspondence service hours to be shared with the MAWSECO business manager, to be used in future consideration of needed service agreements.
8. HLWW District shall be responsible for appropriate coverage for workers' compensation, FICA, PERA, TRA and insurance benefits based on HLWW District's contract language.
9. MAWSECO will pay HLWW technology staff directly for mileage costs.
10. This agreement shall be in force from July 1, 2025, until June 30, 2026. Either party shall provide written notice regarding reduction/discontinuation of service contract with a 90-day notice.
