Proposed Changes for the 26-27 Student Handbook-

Section 2: Attendance, Truancy, and Tardiness

2.1 General Attendance Information

Current: Students will be allowed 10 excused absences as well as up to 5 additional absences for mental or behavioral health illness of the student, from school. Once the student has reached 10 days absent (excused or unexcused), all other absences will be unexcused unless a note from a medical professional is provided or the student is checked by the school nurse. Nothing other than a documented illness will be considered excluded once a student has reached 10 absences.

**Proposed: Students will be allowed 8 excused absences via parent call including up to 5 absences for mental or behavioral health illness of the student, from school. Once a student has reached 8 days absent (excused), all other absences will be considered unexcused unless a note from a medical professional is provided or the student is checked by the school nurse. Nothing other than a documented illness will be considered excused once a student has reached 8 parent call in absences.**
