

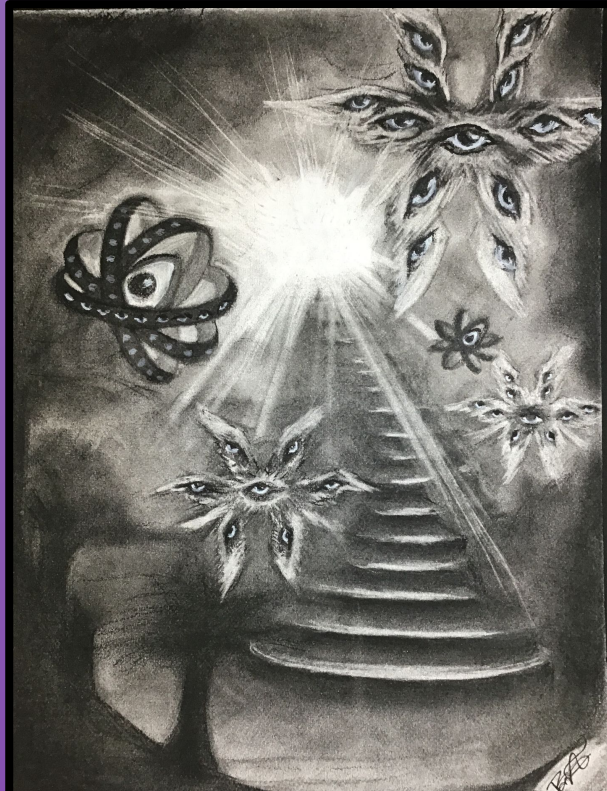

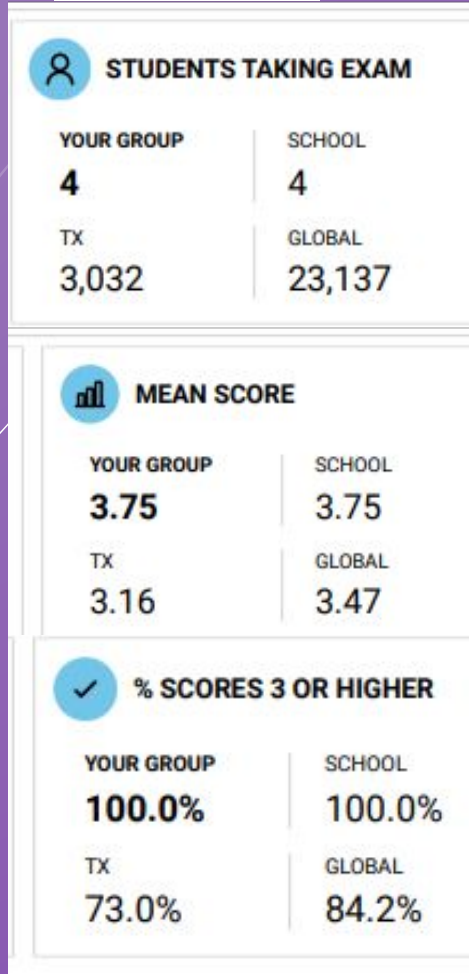

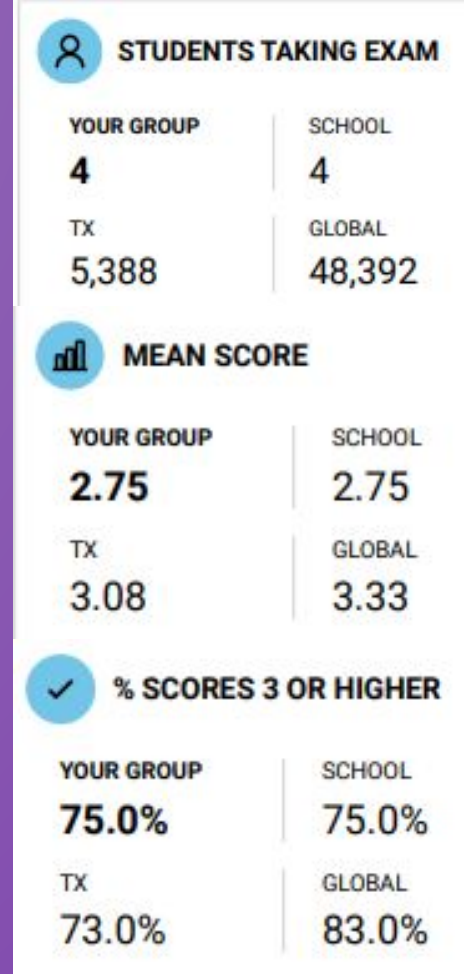

AP Drawing:

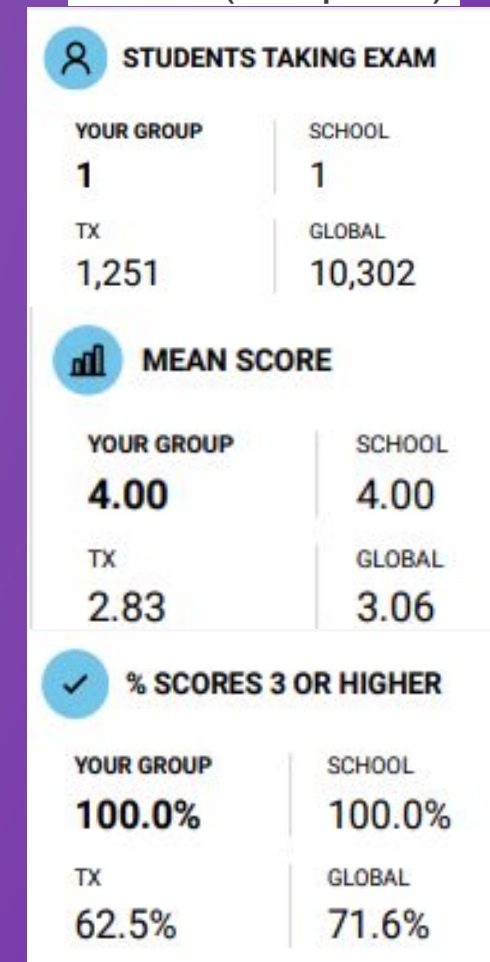

- 56 artworks, 50 advanced to regional qualifying round of judging (45 participants, 43 made playoffs)

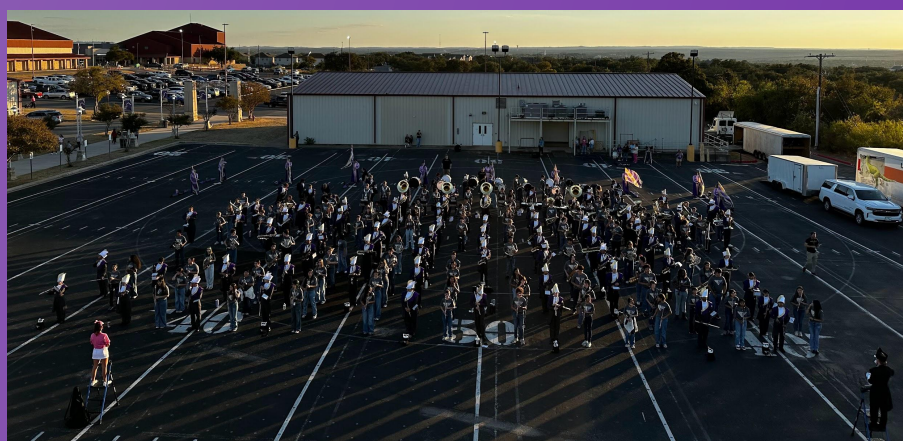

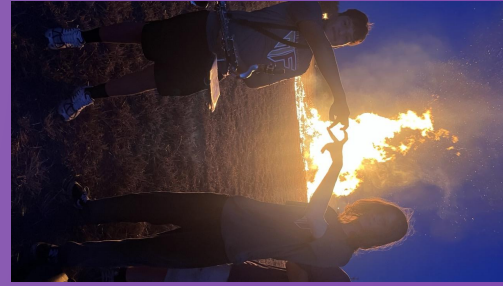

Concert Band Accomplishments

- During the Spring Semester, our Mustang Band program was represented by 5 concert ensembles at the annual UIL Concert and Sight Reading assessment. This is a first for MFISD Band Program.
- 2026 marked the first time in Region 29/32 history that a Middle School band program sent a Sub Non-Varsity group to Concert and Sight Reading.
- We are proud to say that ALL 5 of our Mustang Band concert ensembles earned a Sweepstakes rating at this Spring assessment.
- In addition to this being a historic accomplishment at the Region level, it is also the first time in our district's history that all instrumental concert ensembles received Sweepstakes during the same year.
