Background Information:

In order to engage in long-range planning, MISD administration is presenting two academic calendars: the 2026-2027 SY calendar with designated bad weather days and the 2027-2028 SY calendar for consideration and approval.

The process included an interdepartmental collaboration that designed ways to solicit staff, student and community input. The academic calendar committee considered the input from stakeholders to design two versions of academic calendars for the 2027-2028 school year. Teachers must have 187 work days and students must receive a minimum of 75,600 instructional minutes each academic calendar year.

The district received over 5,000 responses from stakeholders that included initial input on what to consider when designing the academic calendars and votes for their calendar preference. Members of the District Advisory Team shared the desire for teachers to have a professional development day earlier in the fall semester. Input received reflects a desire to recognize and consider Asian and Muslim holidays.
