Parking Permits

Students who choose to park on campus must purchase a yearly parking permit, available for \$350 in Lot A and B of the high school and for \$150 in Lot C. Yearly passes are available by a seniority system. Limited daily parking permits are available for \$5 and must be purchased a day in advance. Permits are to be purchased *online in MyPaymentsPlus and picked up in the student's assigned Student Center* at ~~Student Center South~~. Students must have their driver's license and car license plate number to purchase a permit. A lost parking pass in need of replacement is \$10.

Students driving an e-scooter or e-bike must register this vehicle with the Main Office and purchase a one time permit sticker for \$10. E-scooters or e-bikes may only be parked at the designated bike rack in front of the Main Entrance/Main Office. In accordance with Minnesota State Law, individuals must be at least 15 years of age to operate an electric-assisted bicycle (e-bike)

All drivers of all vehicles need to follow all safety expectations and rules of the road.

E-Bikes on Campus

In accordance with Minnesota State Law, individuals must be at least 15 years of age to operate an electric-assisted bicycle (e-bike). Because many of our students are under the legal operating age, and in order to ensure compliance with state law and maintain campus safety, e-bikes are not permitted on the CMS campus at any time. This includes riding or parking e-bikes on school grounds. Students who bring an e-bike to campus may be subject to school disciplinary action, and families may be contacted to retrieve the device.
