

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE SPRING BRANCH INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT
CLOSURE OF NORTHBROOK MIDDLE SCHOOL and
RELATED BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS**

WHEREAS, across the State of Texas, there has been declining enrollment of students in Texas public schools for varying reasons;

WHEREAS, Spring Branch Independent School District (SBISD or the District) has seen a decline of approximately 2,000 students over the last several years due to factors including, but not limited to, a rise in property values, gentrification, and families moving further out to the suburbs for affordability;

WHEREAS, much of the decline in enrollment in SBISD has been in the feeder patterns of Spring Woods High School and Northbrook High School which include the middle schools of Spring Oaks Middle School, Spring Woods Middle School, Landrum Middle School, and Northbrook Middle School;

WHEREAS, it is a priority of the SBISD Board of Trustees (the Board) and Administration to maintain in our comprehensive middle schools the District's academic and extra-curricular programming and student support services that our students deserve and our community expects, and, in order to do so, SBISD must be efficient and effective with our resources;

WHEREAS, it is difficult to run an efficient and effective comprehensive middle school when it is small and academic and operational resources are being spread across multiple campuses;

WHEREAS, Northbrook Middle School is the smallest of SBISD's comprehensive middle schools with a current enrollment of 452 students;

WHEREAS, enrollment at Northbrook Middle School has declined steadily over multiple recent years;

WHEREAS, for the reasons as stated in this Resolution, the Board seeks to approve the Administration's recommendation to close Northbrook Middle School effective with the 2026-2027 school year; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the closure, the Board seeks to approve boundary adjustments of Spring Oaks Middle School, Spring Woods Middle School, and Landrum Middle School to accept Northbrook Middle School students and to realign Spring Woods Middle School boundaries as presented on April 27, 2026, with the additional adjustment to the Spring Woods Middle School to Spring Oaks Middle School boundary as presented in the map attached as backup to this Resolution, to ensure a more efficient and effective balance of District resources.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Board of Trustees of the Spring Branch Independent School District desires to serve Every Child with high quality academic and extracurricular experiences, services and supports, and, therefore, must be efficient and effective with our resources;
2. Due to steadily declining enrollment and the need to be efficient and effective with our resources, the Board of Trustees of the Spring Branch Independent School District directs the Administration to close Northbrook Middle School effective with the 2026-2027 school year and relocate students to Spring Oaks Middle School, Spring Woods Middle School, and Landrum Middle School to maximize facility usage, staffing, and programs; and
3. The Board of Trustees of the Spring Branch Independent School District directs the Administration to:
 - a. adjust the boundaries of Spring Oaks Middle School, Spring Woods Middle School, and Landrum Middle School to accept Northbrook Middle School students as presented in the Administration's recommendation on April 27, 2026; and
 - b. to realign Spring Woods Middle School boundaries as presented in the Administration's recommendation on April 27, 2026, with the additional adjustment to the Spring Woods Middle School to Spring Oaks Middle School boundary as presented in the map attached as backup to this Resolution, to ensure an efficient and effective balance of District resources.

N: 200

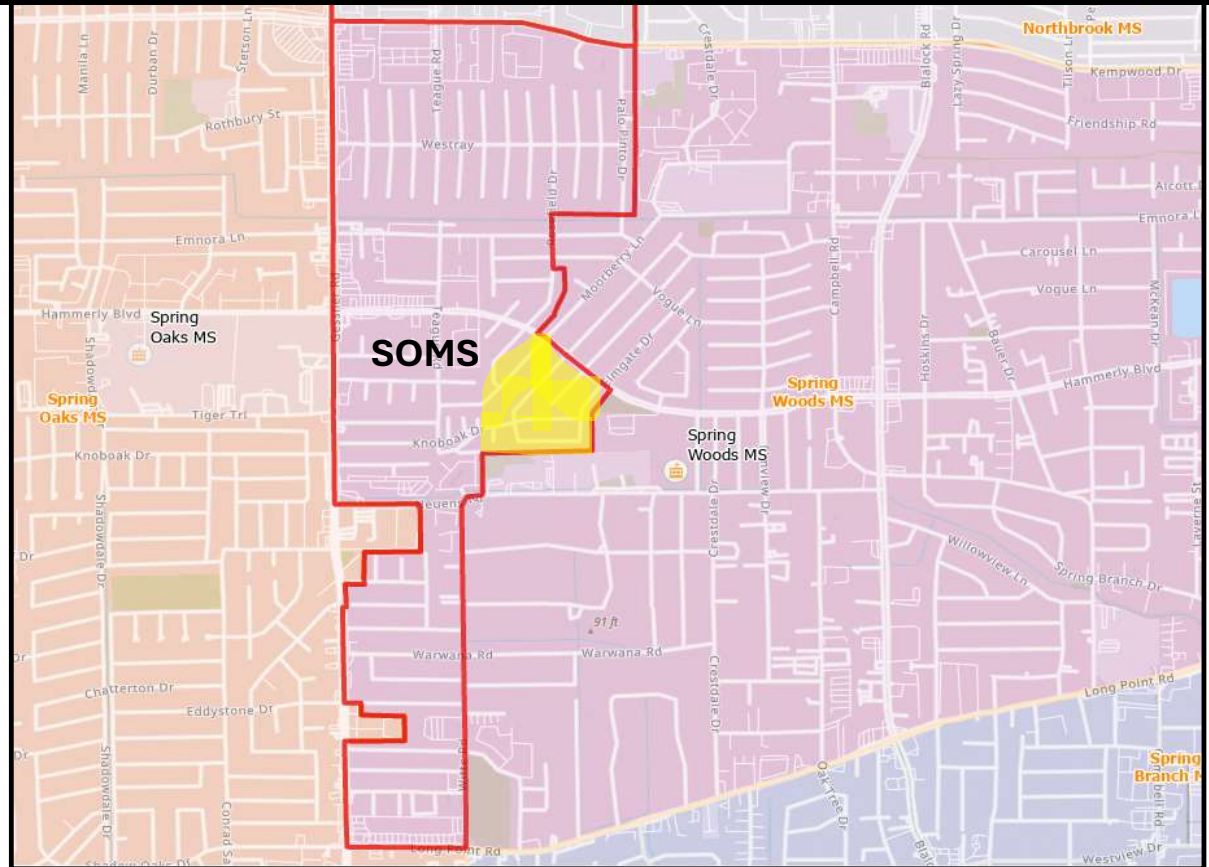
Spring Oaks MS
