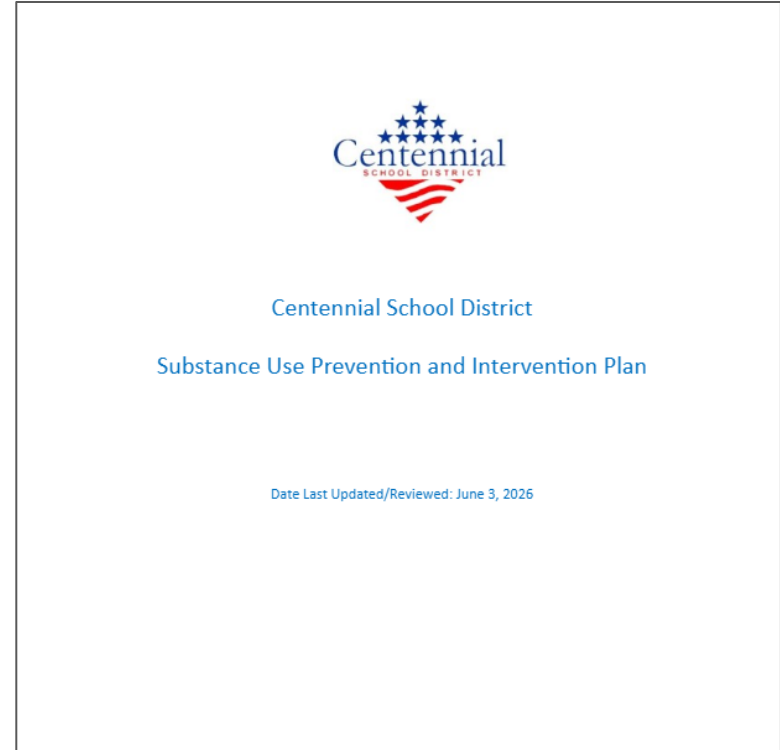


Prevention and Intervention

The Comprehensive Substance Use Prevention and Intervention Plan outlines prevention education, school policies and procedures, resources and referral processes and training and procedures for staff.

- Referral and emergency medical procedures
- Staff Development

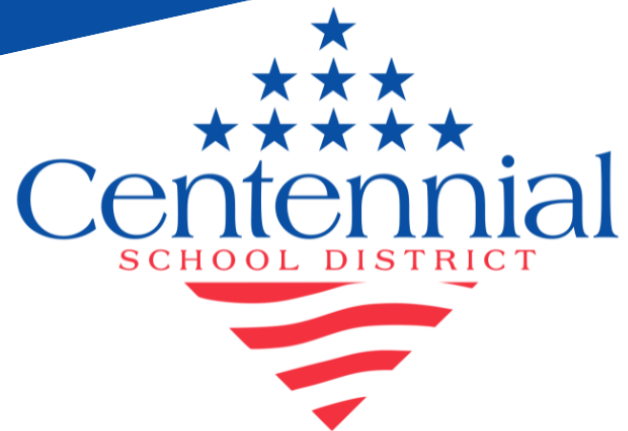
