

Workforce Division Monthly Board Report

March 2026

Summary/Overview

In the annual academic timeline, March is when we are working on budget development and drafted schedules for summer and fall semesters. We are also preparing for our next Industrial Technology Advisory Committee to be held in April. We are currently taking inventory and documenting the applicability of our Industrial Training Equipment for planning purposes.

The Safety Training Center (STC) continues to provide required safety training to the Northern Panhandle Region. The technicians assigned to work at the various plants and refineries cannot do so until they receive the training and subsequent STC documentation. This is a critical mission which supports the regional workforce.

Business and Industry Partners Served

This month the Safety Training Center served 29 regional business and industry partners.

Individuals Served

This month we delivered 534 courses to 175 individuals.

Total Monthly Revenues

This month we reported a total of \$18,765 in gross revenues. This represents 16 training days for the month of March.
