Subject: Consider and take possible action to approve the Second Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement for School Resource Officer Services between San Elizario Independent School District and El Paso County, Texas, reducing the number of assigned School Resource Officers from five (5) to four (4), and authorize the Superintendent to negotiate and execute the amendment and all related documents.
Date: July 29, 2026

HISTORY: On the 1st day of February 2024, the County of El Paso, Texas and the San Elizario Independent School District entered into an Interlocal Agreement for the County and the El Paso County Sheriff's Office to provide school resource officers to SEISD through December 31, 2029 (County Contract 2024-0133). The Agreement was then amended (first amendment) to update the office and supplies section. The County and SEISD now desire to amend the Agreement in the form of this Second Amendment to Interlocal Agreement for School Resource Officers.

RATIONALE: Due to the closure of two school campuses, a reduction in the number of school resource officers can be achieved; from the Sheriff's Office, we are able to reduce the number of assigned Sheriff School Resource Officers from five (5) to four (4). The Agreement with the City of San Elizario for one (1) SRO was not renewed.

BUDGET IMPACT: In reducing the number of assigned Sheriff's office SROs from five (5) to four (4), the estimated savings by the end of the agreement term, December 31, 2029, is estimated to be \$212,385 dollars.

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION: The administrative recommendation is to approve the Second Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement for School Resource Officers.
