Background Information

Midway Virtual School will open in the fall as an innovative learning opportunity for 6th-12th grade students who want flexibility and are ready to take ownership of their education. The virtual program will offer three learning pathways through an online platform. The Full-Time Virtual pathway is a 100% online experience with comprehensive courses delivered by Texas-certified teachers through the Pearson Connexus platform. The Hybrid Learning pathway will allow students to enroll in four or more online courses and attend their remaining courses in a face-to-face setting at their Midway-zoned campus. The à la carte pathway is an online course option for students, both inside and outside of the district. The virtual program is possible due to changes to the TEC Chapter 30 B education code, which took effect in the 2025-2026 school year. Dr. Odajima will present details of the various pathways and give current enrollment and timeline information.
