Authority

When the district receives students who are residents of another school district, it shall assess tuition charges in accordance with the School Code. Tuition shall be assessed for those students who are residents of another school district but whose attendance has been approved by the Board, in accordance with applicable law and Board policy.^[1]^[2]

Delegation of Responsibility

It shall be the responsibility of the Chief Financial Officer Business Manager to invoice tuition for approved students.

Guidelines

Tuition rates shall be determined annually.^[3]

Tuition billings will be made monthly in advance of the attendance period.

When payment is more than sixty (60) days overdue, services will be terminated. Should this occur, such a student will be considered withdrawn from the district, in which case, the district will notify the student's district of residence of the withdrawal required under Section 1332 of the School Code.[4]
