**Agenda Item:** Consider Approval of Utilizing Region 10 as an Authorized Provider for HB 3 Reading Academies

**Summary:**

HB 3 requires that all current 25-26 teachers must be enrolled in a Texas Reading Academies cohort that launches no later than June 2026. Any teacher hired after August 2025 is participating in a June cohort.

For our June cohort of participants, we will use Region 10 as our authorized provider for the academies. They will provide all logistical, technological, and content support for the district. The estimated cost would be **\$27,000.00** funded from our general operating budget.

We have had five successful years of Texas Reading Academies in TISD.
