BBB (LEGAL)

Adopted 11-6-2025

ELECTION DATE

School Boards have the option to **move their general elections for board members to the November uniform election date.** This change must be adopted by board resolution no later than December 31, 2030.



MODIFICATION OF TRUSTEE TERMS

School Boards have the option to adopt **modify the length of trustee terms.** The resolution must explicitly detail how the transition in term lengths will occur.



CURRENT POLICY

ELECTION DATE: MAY

TRUSTEE TERMS: THREE YEARS

ELECTIONS HELD: ANNUALLY

VOTER TURNOUT

- A November general election would likely provide increased voter turnout.



IMPLICATIONS

LENGTH OF TERM FOR CURRENT TRUSTEES



- The transition must begin with the first regular election for trustees that occurs after the board adopts the resolution, and **a trustee who serves on the date the resolution is adopted shall serve the remainder of that term.**
- Elections for Trustees with four-year terms shall be held biennially. **The terms of one-half of the trustees, or as near to one-half as possible expire every two years.**

6 and 7	2024	2027	2028	4 years and 6 months

KEEPING **3 YEAR** TERMS/**NOVEMBER** ELECTION DATE

Place	Current Election Year	Term Change Year	Next Election	Length of term
1 and 2	2025	2028	2028	Additional 6 months
3, 4, and 5	2026	2029	2029	Additional 6 months
6 and 7	2024	2027	2027	Additional 6 months

- Switching to a bi-annual election cycle (four-year terms) would offer cost savings to the District.

- Determine if any change is necessary
 - Election Date – May or November
 - Term Length – Keep 3 year terms or move to 4 year terms
- If no change is necessary, no further action is required
- If the Board wants to further consider a change:
 - Schedule Trustee Connection meetings with stakeholders
 - Schedule a Vote for Election Date Change
 - Schedule a Vote for Term Change
 - Adopt Resolutions for Term Change and/or Date Change if necessary
 - Update Policy BBB (LOCAL) when changes if necessary
