### Background Information:

Keller ISD’s Citizens Bond Advisory Committee – composed of teachers, parents, community members, and administrative staff – met alongside the Long-Range Planning Committee for joint meetings from January to April 2026 to plan for the district’s future. The committees evaluated demographic projections, declining enrollment, rising costs due to inflation and unfunded state mandates, aging facilities, and increased competition among alternative education options.

Together, the joint committees developed criteria to evaluate potential opportunities for campus consolidation to ensure the district is making the most effective use of its school buildings. Following that work, the Citizens Bond Advisory Committee met separately for in-depth discussions about KISD’s facility needs and to consider options for a future bond proposal.

On June 17, 2026, the Citizens Bond Advisory Committee evaluated and voted on the list of projects that would be recommended to be considered by the Board of Trustees for a potential future bond proposal.
