Summary: **Construction of the District's new Athletic Complex is on schedule for completion. In order to ensure the athletic training room at the new athletic fieldhouse is fully operational and ready for use, the District must purchase the necessary athletic training equipment and supplies.**

Background Information :

Existing athletic training equipment and supplies will remain in the current high school athletic training room to continue supporting student-athletes on the main campus. Maintaining fully equipped athletic training rooms at both locations will ensure timely medical care and injury treatment for all student-athletes while supporting practices and events at each facility. Therefore, additional equipment and supplies are required to fully outfit the athletic training room at the new athletic complex fieldhouse.

The purchase will be made through Alert Services, an approved BuyBoard cooperative vendor previously utilized by the District for athletic training equipment and supplies. Continuing with the same vendor provides consistency in equipment, compatibility with existing products, and dependable service and support.
