



RFP 26-30 Student Behavioral Intervention Curriculum

- **Purpose:** Ector County ISD (ECISD) is seeking approval from the ECISD Board of Trustees to award a contract resulting from Request for Proposal (RFP) 26-35 Addendum 1: Student Behavioral Intervention Curriculum Related to HB 114 with Synchronous, Asynchronous, In-Class, and After-Hour Delivery Options.
- **Background Info:** Ector County ISD (ECISD) is seeking to implement a research-based student behavioral intervention curriculum to ensure compliance with Texas House Bill 114 (HB 114) and Texas Education Code §29.906, which require districts to provide structured intervention education for students involved in substance-related incidents, including drugs, alcohol, and vaping. The proposed program emphasizes prevention, behavior change, and skill development and will be delivered through flexible formats, including synchronous and asynchronous options during the school day, after hours, or in alternative settings. It will serve students across grades K–12 and allow for assignment to individuals, small groups, or broader prevention efforts while providing tracking and reporting capabilities to document student participation and outcomes for compliance and monitoring purposes, aligning with ECISD’s commitment to student well-being and safe, supportive learning environments.
- **Cost:** Not to Exceed \$86,000/year
- **Funding Source:** Title IV - 289
