Agenda Item: Consider Approval of the Speech Services Contract To Implement Students' IEP Services

Summary:

The district provides speech therapy services for approximately 352 students. Speech therapy services fall under students' special education IEP services.

Due to zero applicants for these vacant positions, the district is securing licensed professionals to provide speech IEP services for the 26-27 school year. Each candidate has been interviewed and checked for proper credentials. The district has a history of successfully contracting these services with Spotter staffing.

Contract services for Licensed Speech Language Pathologist with a Certificate of Clinical Competence in Communication (CCC) and a Licensed Speech Language Pathologist-Assistant. Contracting these services is required due to a lack of applicants for this position.

Contract and secure Speech Therapy IEP services are provided during an estimated 12-week period for two SLP-Assistants that will be out on maternity leave.
