The Summer Food Service Program's (SFSP) underwent an on-site assessment on 7/7/2026, for the month of June, conducted by OPI (Sydney Dickinson). This review is currently open, and will close when OPI has received all requested documentation. Food Service has submitted most required paperwork, and is collaborating with other departments to submit the final documents. These reviews recur on a 5-year basis.

- OPI will be conducting a review for the SNP regular school-year nutrition program in October 2026. These reviews recur on a 5-year basis.

The Summer Food Service Program provided 400 child meals during the Blackfeet Youth Day event located at All Chief's Park on July 8, 2026, and 190 child meals during the first day of NAID on July 9, 2026.

The Warehouse continues to operate on their summer schedule. Carrying out their daily operations efficiently, which includes providing assistance for the school kitchens, food deliveries, and mail.

All Warehouse and Food Service staff that utilize district vehicles have filled and signed the new transportation documents, as well as filed driver's license copies with Transportation.

The food service program has filled 3 new permanent positions in the following areas: (2) assistant cooks at Napi, (1) assistant cook at Bullshoe. Current vacancies include: (1) head cook at Napi kitchen, (1) assistant cook at BES, and (1) assistant cook for the Supper Program.

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
