The regular meeting of the Okemos Board of Education was called to order by President Buffett at 7:00 p.m.

Director Lentz presented the multi-year budget projection and reviewed the impact of \$1.2 million in budget reductions, as well as the proposed 2026-27 Budget Reductions and Revenue Enhancements. Superintendent Matt Olson presented outcomes from May 26, 2026, Board Work Session. The Board's average rankings are aligned closely with the administrative rankings. Superintendent Olson reviewed the levels of proposed reductions, including Levels Two and Three, which are not recommended for implementation at this time.

The board discussed in length the proposed budget reduction items by board rankings.
