

Consider approval of the submission of the Dual Credit Faculty Expansion Project Resolution for 2026-2027.

1. Background:

Advanced Academics department is requesting approval of the Dual Credit Faculty Expansion Project Resolution. The Dual Credit Faculty Expansion Project is an initiative designed to increase the number of qualified high school instructors who are credentialed to teach college-level dual credit courses. By supporting teachers in obtaining the necessary graduate coursework and certifications, the project helps expand student access to early college opportunities. Participants will sign a promissory note and reimbursement agreement. The program will begin in the 2026 Summer I session.

2. Process:

Teachers that were qualified, submitted a DCFEP Teacher Interest Form to district liaison signed by their campus principal. After determining nominations, the Director of Advanced Academics submitted a DCFEP Implementation Plan for candidates. Alamo Colleges reviewed Implementation Plan and awarded SWISD four allocations for candidates to participate in DCFEP.
