NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees of the United Independent School District does hereby resolve its intent to, rescind previous action and that now the above named school attendance areas are to be designated as a hazardous area for school transportation purposes, and

That students residing in the above residential areas shall become eligible for school transportation to and from their homes.
