Guiding Outcome:	Exceptional Workplace Environment
Summary:	This item requests approval of the Police/School Liaison Interlocal Agreement between Denton County and Denton ISD whereas Denton County shall provide Denton ISD with one certified police officer to serve as school resource officer (SRO) (assignments below).
Background Information/ Previous Board Action:	This is a service provided by Denton County to assist our schools in their jurisdiction with a School Resource Officer. One (1) certified police officer will be assigned to Harpool Middle School and supporting Adkins, EP Razor, and Blanton Elementary schools. The new MOU payment terms include a quarterly payment option. The Denton ISD Board of Trustees have approved similar agreements with the City of Aubrey, City of Denton, Town of Little Elm, and the City of Oak Point to provide SROs to our campuses in their jurisdiction.
Potential Operational Impact:	Establishes and delineates the mission of the SRO Program. Also, formalizes relationships between the participating entities to foster an efficient and cohesive program that will build a positive relationship with the youth of the community.
Potential Financial Impact:	One SRO for 100% reimbursement of salary/benefits and vehicle usage fee for a quarterly payment of \$39,313.25 and totaling \$157,253.00.
Recommendation (Consent or New Business Only):	Approval of Budget Impact Statement for SRO MOU between Denton County and Denton ISD where Denton County will provide one certified police officer.
