Goal 1: All students perform at or above expectations



Goal #1, Objective 1.1: We will annually evaluate the success and development of meeting the five goals of the CACR plan

1. All children are ready for school
2. Prepare students to be lifelong learners
3. All racial and economic achievement gaps between students are closed
4. All students are ready for career and college
5. All students graduate from high school



All Children are Ready for School

2023-2024

Goal 1 was met: 91% of students entering kindergarten Fall 2024, were able to demonstrate the social emotional skill of cooperative play with their peers (dimension 2c.).

Goal 2 was met: 100% of students entering kindergarten Fall 2024 were able to demonstrate use and appreciation of books and other texts (dimension 17a.).

2024-2025

1. 92% of early education students entering kindergarten Fall of 2025 will demonstrate the social emotional skill of cooperative play with their peers. Cooperative play being defined as interacting with their peers with shared goals as they play.

2. 85% of early education students entering kindergarten in the Fall of 2025 will demonstrate the ability to emotionally regulate by utilizing higher level thinking, looking at situations differently, or delaying gratification for the sake of problem solving.

3. 98% of Early Education students entering kindergarten Fall of 2025 will demonstrate use and appreciation of books and other texts.

2023-2024

10% of Special Education students were proficient on the MCA III reading test in April 2024. 83 students tested in this category. (State Average: 22.3%)

2024-2025

HLWW will increase MCA reading test scores across all racial, economic and special education gaps by at least 2%.

Special ed students will increase their MCA reading scores from 10% to 12%.
