Subject: 2026 – 2027 FSHISD Student Code of Conduct

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Chapter 37 of the Texas Education Code requires that each school district develop and maintain a local Student Code of Conduct. The Code must address the legal requirements of student codes of conduct and is organized by provisions of law that communicate to students, parents, school staff, and the community exactly what is expected of students and how misconduct will be handled.

State law requires that the Student Code of Conduct be approved by the board. The Code stands as an authoritative document on its own, and once adopted, has the force of policy.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION

The Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) annually publishes a Model Student Code of Conduct with most updates occurring in odd-numbered years after a legislative session. Fort Sam Houston ISD used the most current TASB Model to develop its local Student Code of Conduct to remain in alignment with legal requirements.

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION

I recommend the approval of the Fort Sam Houston ISD 2026 – 2027 Student Code of Conduct, as submitted.
