On November 30, 2016, the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) issued a Notice to Proceed to Denton Independent School District for the Clean Fleets North Texas 2015 Call for Projects. Currently, NCTCOG and Denton Independent School District are coordinating an Amendment to the Agreement to increase the award amount and scope of the project to include the procurement and purchase of two (2) additional vehicles.

While staff is working towards finalizing the Amendment to the Agreement, NCTCOG extends the following Limited Notice to Proceed.

This letter authorizes Denton Independent School District to begin procurement activities and purchase of sixteen (16) new vehicles (Activities 1-16 in the enclosed Scope of Work). Reimbursement for these activities shall not exceed \$796,000 and must be consistent with the terms of the original Agreement executed on November 22, 2016. Reimbursement of expenses associated with Activities 15 and 16 are contingent on the full execution of the Amendment to the Agreement.
