

Hello,

We can write up a new agreement. A couple of things. According to Heather, the structure is approx. 20 ft off the pavement. So any contractor would have to drive a jet/vac on to the lawn to access. If we must do any repairs due to rutting of the lawn, that would be included in the time and material, unless the Twp want to take care of. Of course, we would take every effort to do work during frozen ground/ dry ground.

Does the township want us to just do this structure only or other's as well? Regardless of who cleans it, the Township would need to do your CB inspection / reports for NPDES II reporting. You should have your staff do that and then tell us which structures you want done. Remember regular CB sumps are cleaned if they are 30% to 40% full.

Either way I believe this would not take more than 1-day. Our time/ material is approx. \$4,500/whole day. This would be MAX.
