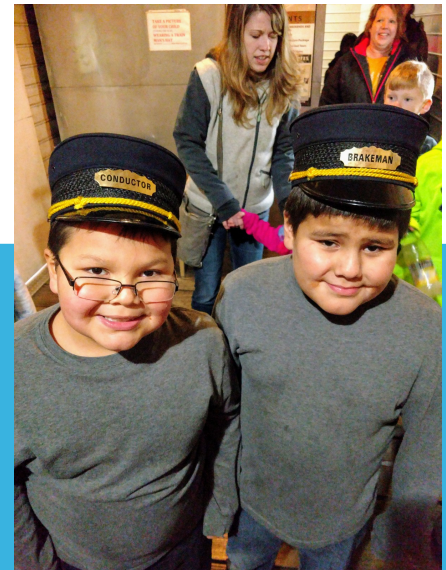


WHAT HAPPENS EACH NIGHT?

- Students in grades 1-4 attend the afterschool program from 3:30-5:30.
 - Students can attend Monday-Friday, or on nights that work for their family.
 - From 3:45-4:20 students receive academic tutoring, homework help, supportive instruction in reading/language arts and math. This is dependent upon the students' needs.
 - From 4:20-4:45 students eat a free dinner, which has been made possible through the After School Food Program. Becky Frisby has done an incredible job making sure the meals are great for students.
 - From 4:45-5:30 students engage in academic enrichment activities, which range from LEGO engineering, various STEM projects, and other hands-on and high interest learning activities.
 - At 5:30, students head home on the bus or get picked up. Transportation is free for all students who attend the program. This is a requirement of the grant.
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YEAR 5 AND RESULTS OF SITE MONITORING VISIT FROM 2017-18

- As we are in year five of a five-year grant. We will need to apply for the next cycle of the CLC grant by Jan 30th, 2019
- The After School Coordinator, Cola DeNucci, will work with Mr. DeWitt and other District staff to complete this grant.
- After the success of last years site visit, Cola was asked to present at the state CLC conference.
 - Our site has fantastic parent involvement, so she was able to share information about how to help other sites with their parent involvement and events.
