Background Information: In accordance with Board Policy BF(LOCAL), local policies may be adopted or amended by a majority of the Board at any regular or special meeting, provided that Board members have received advance written notice of the proposed change and the item has been placed on the meeting agenda. Legally referenced (LEGAL) policies are reviewed but not adopted by the Board.

Policy proposals or amendments may be initiated by the Superintendent, Board members, district staff, or community members. However, such proposals are generally submitted to the Board with a recommendation from the Superintendent.

Update 125 includes revisions to LEGAL policies reflecting recent legislative and regulatory changes. Corresponding updates to LOCAL policies are proposed to ensure alignment with these legal updates and current administrative practices. Following review by district administration, it is recommended that the Board approve all LOCAL policy revisions as detailed in the attached Local Policy Comparison packet and Explanatory Notes.
