FROM THE ELEMENTARY:

All students perform at or above expectations

- 60 % of students across the district made typical to aggressive growth towards target proficiency. We continue to target skill acquisition, and are making plans.
- New ELA standards will be in place for the fall– alignment taking place.
- Review of Reading curriculum will begin, with the intent to best support students and meet the guidance of MDE requirements.

All students feel they belong and are supported

- Intentional positive contacts/communication home continue
- End of year assemblies honored academic and citizenship related rewards.
- 4th grade “clap outs” were a great celebration to send students into the summer and onto 5th grade.

Effective and efficient use of resources

- MDE for a “Desk Review” for Title I programs has been returned with one minor adjustment. Overall, a positive experience and review, and MDE staff made a special acknowledgement to our staff for the thoroughness of the documents provided as “evidence” of appropriate use and services provided for students.
