Site Council Meeting Notes
June 1, 2026

In Attendance: Ben Bickle, Liz Elkins, Damian Crowson

The Master Schedule for the 2026–2027 school year was released to staff on Friday. Several adjustments have been made to support student needs and course offerings, including Ricky Franco teaching one section of Spanish 2 and Braden Monnot teaching two periods of Physical Education. New courses being added next year include the Early Childhood Education (ECE) Career and Technical Education program, German, and AP Biology, which will be taught by Melissa Farmer.

All staffing positions have been filled for the upcoming school year. New additions and transfers include Stephanie Nygren, who will transfer into the B7/Ed Lab position, and Ryan Marrs, who joins Hidden Valley as the College and Career Counselor. Ryan brings valuable experience from his previous roles as Graduation Coach at Eagle Point High School for the past eight years and as a counselor with Hearts With A Mission. He will also serve as Head Girls Basketball Coach.

The administrative team reviewed graduation plans for the Class of 2027, including indoor and outdoor ceremony layouts, seating arrangements, contingency plans, and procedures for weather-related decisions. Technology updates were also discussed. Chromebook carts will be housed in core academic classrooms, while students needing individual or overnight Chromebook access may check devices out through the library. Computer labs D6 and D9 will remain available through a sign-up process and can be utilized by teachers who do not have access to Chromebook carts for classroom projects and instructional activities.

The Booster Club continues preparations for two major fundraising events. The annual Golf Tournament is scheduled for June 20, 2026, at Dutcher Creek Golf Course, and the Booster Club Auction will be held in January 2027 at the Josephine County Fairgrounds.

A district-wide 6–12 Discipline Matrix is currently being finalized and will be implemented during the 2026–2027 school year to provide consistency in student behavior expectations and consequences. Athletics wrapped up a successful spring season. At the State Track and Field Championships, Peter Moline earned 9th and 10th place finishes, Erin Moline placed 11th, Mason finished 12th, and the relay team placed 11th. Baseball and softball have also concluded their seasons.

Looking ahead, teachers will report back on August 24, 2026, and freshmen will begin school on August 31, 2026, with all other student start dates following the district calendar. In other business, the Hidden Valley Area Kickoff Meeting will be held at Fruitdale Elementary School.
