



AGREEMENT FOR COLLECTION OF PROPERTY TAXES

This Agreement made this _____ day of _____, 2026 by and between **New Buffalo Area Schools**, with offices at 1112 E. Clay St., New Buffalo, Michigan (hereinafter called "District") and the City of New Buffalo, with offices located at 224 W. Buffalo St., New Buffalo, Michigan (hereinafter called "City"), pursuant to 1976 PA451, as amended, for the purpose of providing for the collection by the City of a summer and a winter levy of 50% of the District property taxes for the year 2026.

The parties agree as follows:

1. The City agrees to collect 50% of the total district property taxes as certified by the District for levy on July 1, 2026 on property located in the City; and to collect 50% of the total district property taxes as certified by the District for levy on December 1, 2026, on property located in the City.
2. The District agrees to reimburse the City as follows: \$1.76 per parcel (.88 for the summer and .88 for the winter)
3. No later than June 15, 2026, the District shall certify to the City the school millage to be levied on property for the tax collection in 2026.
4. The City Treasurer shall account for and deliver winter school tax collection according to the following schedule: Taxes collected between the 1st and 15th of each month, beginning in July will be remitted within 10 business days after the 15th of each month. Taxes collected between the 16th and the ending day of the month will be remitted within 10 business days after the ending day of the month.
5. The City will retain any interest monies on their tax account that accrue from said tax collections. The District will be entitled to interest paid as a late fee by taxpayers paying after the deadline established for collection of summer property taxes.
