

SECOND AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
FOR SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS

On the 1st day of February, 2024, the County of El Paso, Texas ("County") and the San Elizario Independent School District ("SEISD") (collectively, the "Parties") entered into an Interlocal Agreement for the County and the El Paso County Sheriff's Office ("EPCSO") to provide school resource officers to SEISD through December 31, 2029 (County Contract 2024-0133) ("Agreement"). The Agreement was then amended to update the office and supplies section (County Contract 2025-2029). The County and SEISD now desire to amend the Agreement in the form of this Second Amendment to Interlocal Agreement For School Resource Officers.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Interlocal Agreement for School Resource Officers effective February 1, 2024, through December 31, 2029 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, due to campus closures and changes in operational needs, SEISD no longer requires five (5) School Resource Officers and desires to reduce the number of School Resource Officers assigned under the Agreement from five (5) to four (4); and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Amendment to Section I(A)

Effective July 29, 2026, Section I(A) of the Agreement is amended to replace the reference to "Five (5) School Resource Officers" with "Four (4) School Resource Officers."

Section I(A) shall therefore provide that El Paso County Sheriff's Office will provide four (4) School Resource Officers to SEISD.

2. Compensation Adjustment

Effective July 29, 2026, all compensation due under Section III of the Agreement shall be adjusted to reflect the reduction from five (5) School Resource Officers to four (4) School Resource Officers.

The Parties agree that County shall invoice SEISD for four (4) School Resource Officers and the corresponding vehicle costs associated with four (4) School Resource Officers beginning on the effective date of this Amendment.

The Parties may execute a written compensation schedule reflecting the revised annual and quarterly amounts, which shall be incorporated into this Amendment by reference.

3. Ratification

Except as expressly modified herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged and in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and confirmed.

4. Effective Date

This Amendment shall become effective on July 29, 2026.
