TOPIC: Approval of Paving Project

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District, accept the recommendation from the Owner's Representative, Plante Moran Realpoint, and approve for the paving project Best Asphalt, Inc., Romulus, Michigan. This project consists of paving projects at Central Office, Franklin High School and the Bentley Track with a total cost not to exceed \$1,450,759.

This is a planned sinking fund project that will take place over the summer of 2025. The paving at the Central Office Complex, Franklin High School's student parking lot and the Bentley field track are in poor condition and in need of replacement.
