### **REQUIRED SUMMER SCHOOL**

Snyder ISD is committed to ensuring every student has a successful educational experience and that graduates are prepared for future success. Required summer learning opportunities are available for students needing credit recovery, end-of-course (EOC) retesting, attendance recovery, or support after not meeting STAAR requirements. In addition, K–2 students below grade level in reading may be required to attend. These sessions provide targeted support to help students stay on track, build confidence, and strengthen essential skills.

Monday – Thursday from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. at Snyder Primary School (K-5) and Snyder High School (6-12).

- Session 1: 8:00 a.m. – 9:55 a.m. for Reading (Phonics) / Math / Intervention
- Session 2: 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. for Math / Reading / Intervention

#### Secondary Programs

- Junior High / High School: Credit Recovery and Attendance Recovery
- STAAR EOC Boot Camp: June 1 – June 25
- EOC Retesting: June 22 – June 25

**Athletics:** Students required to attend summer school will not be permitted to attend sports camps during scheduled summer school hours. Summer school attendance lists must be provided to Coach Gonzales.

#### **Qualifications for Attendance:**

- Failed a core class (credit recovery/graduation requirement)
- Less than 90% attendance
- Failed STAAR / EOC assessment

Parents should be informed of expectations as soon as possible.

## **OPTIONAL SUMMER LEARNING June 1 - June 25, 2026**

Snyder ISD is excited to offer summer learning opportunities designed to keep students engaged and growing throughout the summer. Our goal is to strengthen reading and math skills while helping prevent the “summer slide,” or the learning loss that can occur when school is not in session. Through engaging, flexible activities and easy-to-access resources, students can build confidence, reinforce core skills, and return to school prepared for success. Whether reading a great book or solving math challenges, every minute matters.

Grade Level K-8

Monday – Thursday from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. at Snyder Primary School.

- Session 1: 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. for Reading (Phonics) / Math / Intervention
- Session 2: 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. for Math / Reading / Intervention

Student Scheduling Options

- Session A: 2 hours of RLA content (for students needing RLA only)
- Session B: 2 hours of Math content (for students needing Math only)
- Session C: 2 hours of RLA and 2 hours of Math (4 total hours)

Example Schedule

- Ana attends Session 1 Reading and Session 2 Math, with intervention pull-out support during the week as needed.
- Johnny attends Session 1 Math and Session 2 Reading, with intervention pull-out support during the week as needed.

Students attending the Scurry County Youth Center will be transported after lunch.

### **ADDITIONAL DETAILS**

**Staffing:** Must be a certified teacher and apply.

#### **Compensation:**

- Pay will be paid on July 15 as a separate check
- Teachers working required summer school:  $\frac{1}{2}$  daily rate
- Teachers working optional summer learning:  $\frac{1}{4}$  daily rate for June
- Aides are paid an hourly rate
- Free breakfast and lunch provided

#### **Technology:**

- Elementary: Details coming soon
- Secondary: Once enrollment is finalized, student devices will be pulled and assigned to carts.

**Food Service:** Students must eat both breakfast and lunch on campus. State regulations no longer allow grab-and-go meal service.

**Summer Meal Dates:** May 26 – June 26

- Breakfast: 7:30 a.m. – 8:30 a.m.
- Lunch: 11:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.

No identification is required for students to receive meals.
