Agenda Topic:	Amendment for the DCFWS 8&11 (Paloma Creek Water Districts) and DISD SROs
Type of Item:	Consent
Guiding Outcome:	Exceptional Workplace Environment
Summary:	This item requests approval of the Amendment to the DCFWS 8&11 (Paloma Creek Water Districts) and Denton ISD SROs for the removal of one (1) SRO due to the Paloma Creek Elementary closure.
Background Information/ Previous Board Action:	This is a service provided by Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 8 & 11 (DCFWS 8 & 11) to assist our schools in their jurisdiction with one School Resource Officer assigned to Bell Elementary and one School Resource Officer assigned to Paloma Creek Elementary. The Board of Trustees originally signed this agreement August 14, 2018, with the DCFWS 8 & 11 providing 75% and Town of Little Elm contributing 25% for the financial costs for the SROs at Bell and Paloma Creek Elementary. Last year's amendment on July 29, 2025, reduced the payments of both entities as Denton ISD contributes the State's annual allotment of \$15,000 per school for a total of \$30,000 per HB 3. This year the amendment is to remove one (1) SRO due to the Paloma Creek Elementary closure and capture the \$33,540.00 for the current state allotment. The Denton ISD Board of Trustees have approved similar agreements with the Town of Little Elm for SROs to our campuses.
Potential Operational Impact:	Establishes and delineates the mission of the SRO Program. Also, formalizes relationships between the participating entities to foster an efficient and cohesive program that will build a positive relationship with the youth of the community.
Potential Financial Impact:	Denton ISD to annually contribute to costs now of only Bell Elementary SRO at \$33,540.00 per HB 3 state allotment starting for 26.27 school year.
Recommendation (Consent or New Business Only):	Approval of the Amendment to the SRO MOU between DCFWS 8 & 11 and Denton ISD where Town of Little Elm will provide one certified police officer.
