What

Who

High school graduates in the AC service area, beginning with the Class of 2026.

Duration

Up to three years or 45 semester credit hours.

HOW TO QUALIFY

Earn 15 hours of dual credit with Amarillo College while in high school

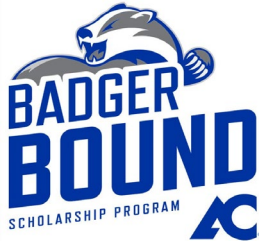
Enroll at AC for the summer or fall semester right after graduation
(within 3 years)

D & D students do qualify.
CE courses/programs do not qualify

HOW TO CLAIM

AC automatically identifies and contacts eligible students.

During senior year:

- **Complete** the *Change of Major Form*.
- **Submit** the *FAFSA*

Can take summer classes if they have current FAFSA

HOW TO KEEP

You must avoid academic and financial aid suspension to remain eligible.

The eligibility clock (3 years/45 SCH) continues even during a suspension period.
