

## **Buildings & Grounds Projects**

These are some updated priced estimates for building and grounds projects to begin this summer. I'm still waiting on a fencing company and T L Sund to contact me on getting some firm estimates on the concrete work and fence projects.

**Football field scoreboard** - \$28K -31K New wireless LED scoreboard. Our present scoreboard is rather old (1986) and we have bulbs that go on and off when we use it. We can no longer get replacement parts for it. This quote is for a 8' x 25' x 8" score board with programmable team names and white digital numbers/letters. This also includes a controller, a sponsor panel, and a school name arch across the top. With installation from Love Signs in Kearney, I'm guessing we'll be pushing \$31K or a little more.

**Fence Repairs** – \$3K. We have some fencing that needs repaired around the track/football field. This is a guess since we're having trouble getting a fence contractor to come and look at our projects.

**Gutters on the High School roof** - \$5K. Put gutters on the high school roof to keep the water from eroding the ground below the scuppers.

**Concrete pad for the courtyard** - \$10K Fill in the garden area in the "courtyard" with concrete and put 2 or 3 picnic tables in for seniors/juniors in good standing to eat lunch out there. T L Sund is supposed to be coming in the next week or so to give us a quote.

**Three new security cameras** - \$6K This would add a 270-degree camera off the NE corner of the bus barn to get the north part of the parking lot and street areas. Add a 180-degree camera to the west side of the bus barn to get the north end of the faculty parking lot. Add a 180-degree camera on the east side of the elementary playground. Presently we don't have a camera with a good view of this part of the playground.

**Two LED flood lights** for the south high school entrance - \$2K

Total cost of all of these items is \$54K to \$57K

We should hold off on refinishing the old gym till after the Unicameral address's schools using native American mascots. There is money, \$200K associated with the cost of district's having change mascots in the proposal. I'm guessing with next years legislature having a 90-day session, the bill will probably come up for debate.

### **Additional Items:**

Concrete pad for the cardboard recycling trailer to get it off the street. We'll need to also cut and grind the curb when we pour the concrete pad for the trailer. These items will come out of

the building fund. We'll bundle these two items with the concrete for the student courtyard and pour them all at the same time.

Move the trash dumpsters to the back of the building
