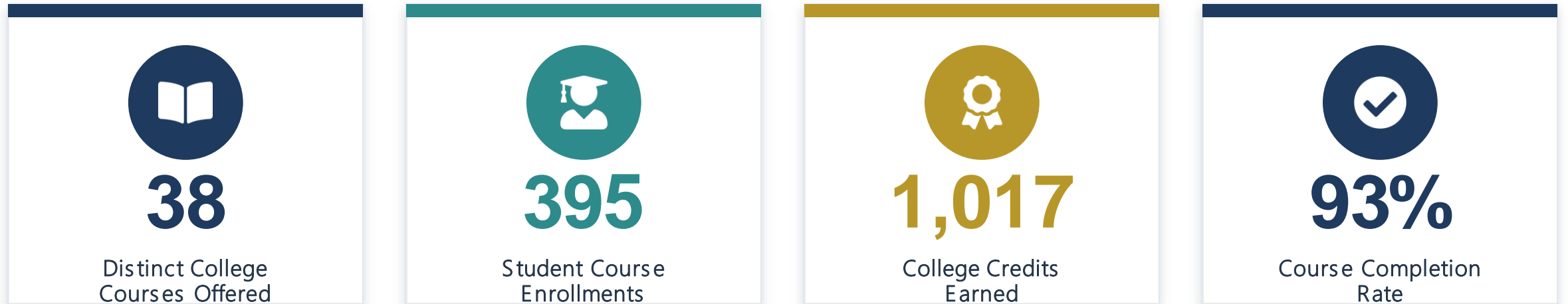

Dual Enrollment by the Numbers

Across two high schools, Saginaw students are earning real college credit — and banking real savings — before they graduate.



Estimated tuition value of credits earned: **\$507,000 – \$722,000**

Based on 1,017 college credits earned, valued at published Michigan-resident tuition rates (CMU to U-M Ann Arbor).

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

One Program, Three Pathways to College Credit

Dual enrollment lets Saginaw high schoolers take genuine college courses — earning credit that counts toward a degree, at little to no cost to families.

College courses taught by faculty from elite universities — Arizona State, Brown, Cornell, and Wesleyan — brought directly into Saginaw classrooms.

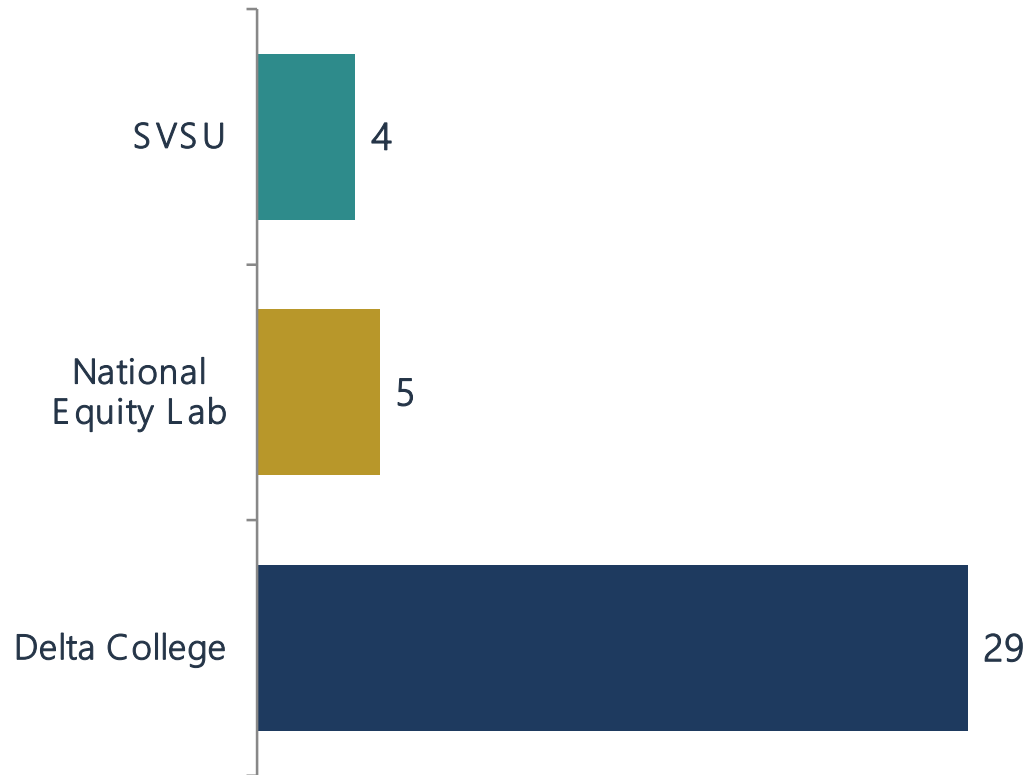

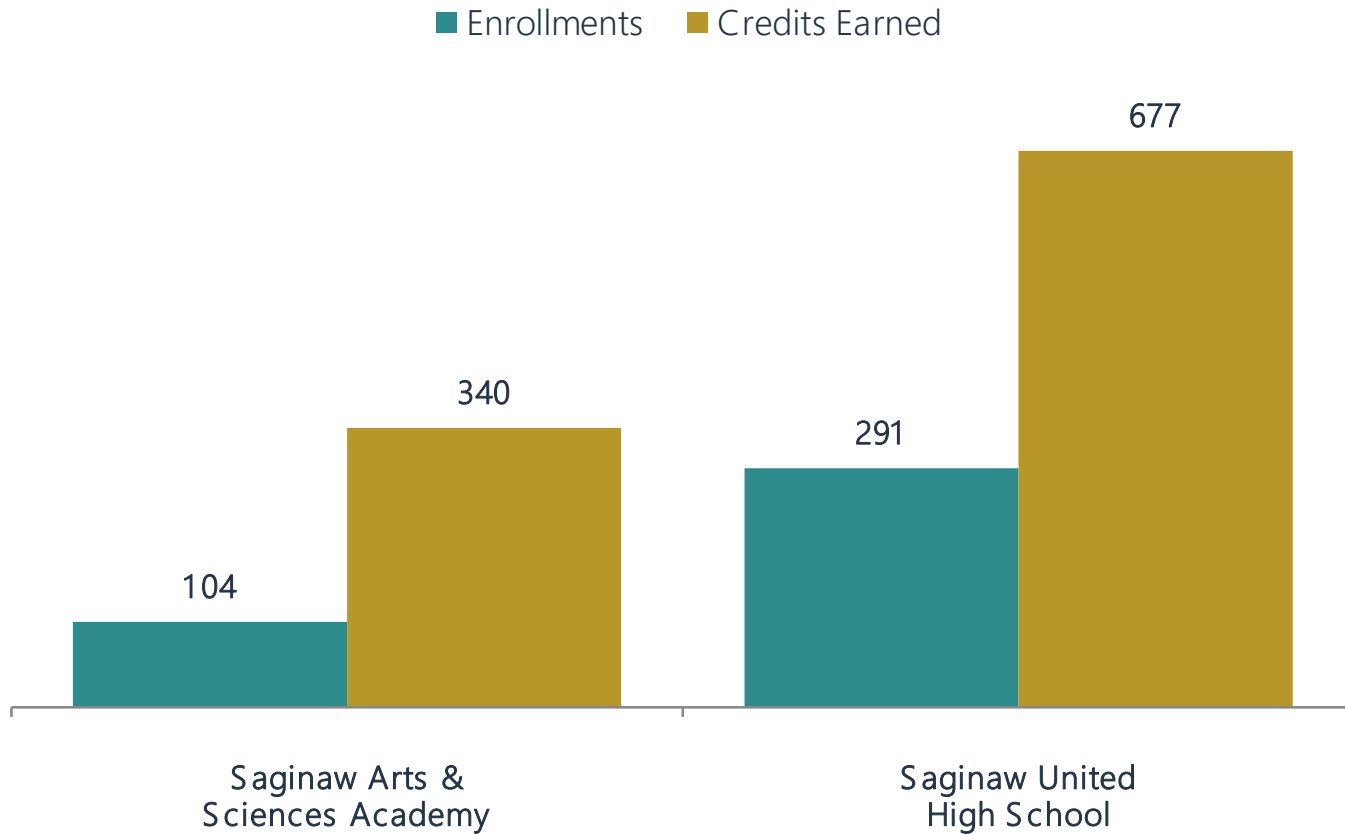

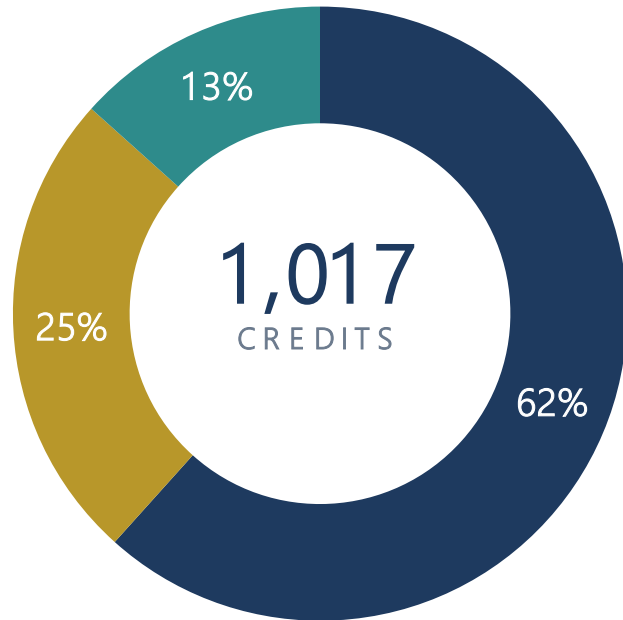

Value Delivered at Each Campus

Estimated tuition value of credits earned, shown across the same four Michigan universities.

Across the district, dual enrollment generated more than half a million dollars in college-tuition value this year alone.

395 enrollments and a 93% completion rate show students see themselves as college learners — before they leave us.

This year, dual enrollment turned classroom seats into **1,017 college credits** and more than **half a million dollars** in tuition value for Saginaw families. Our charge now is to grow access, deepen completion, and make college credit the expectation — not the exception.
