Minutes from the January 26, 2026, Finance Committee Meeting

The minutes from the January 26, 2026, Finance Committee meeting were reviewed. Those present came to a consensus that the minutes accurately reflected the meeting's discussion.

Student and Staff Device Purchase Authorization

The administration provided details on their recommendation to purchase Chromebooks, laptops, and desktop computers for the District ahead of schedule due to expected cost increases and supply shortages in the tech industry. It is expected that, based on vendor feedback, the District will achieve cost savings by locking in the purchase of this equipment at this time and ensuring the equipment is properly supplied for FY2026-2027. The committee authorized the administration to move forward with the purchase of the equipment totaling \$345,740.

Village of Lisle Downtown TIF No. 3 Extension

The administration gave a presentation regarding the Village of Lisle's plan to extend the Downtown TIF No. 3 for an additional twelve years to further incentivize development of the Family Square property. After meeting with the Village of Lisle, the Superintendent had secured a promise of an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA)/Letter of Intent with the Village to declare 100% of the incremental property tax revenues, attributable to Arbor Station Townhomes development within the Village Downtown TIF, as surplus for the District and overlapping taxing bodies. The Mayor of the Village of Lisle, Mary Jo Mullen, answered Finance Committee questions and provided further background on the TIF and the planned development of the area. The administration recommended that the Board of Education approve the District's Letter of Support for the TIF extension in the regular board meeting.

Student Fees for 2026-2027 School Year

The administration provided the Finance Committee with preliminary figures regarding the potential reinstatement of book and supply fees, starting FY2026-2027. The Finance Committee held discussions with the administration about the impact of the fees and related fees, such as the District's subsidy of the cosmetology program at TCD. No decision was made, and there was no proposal introduced in the regular board meeting. The administration is expected to reintroduce this topic, with additional discussion during the March Finance Committee meeting, and a decision to be made by April.

Agenda Topics for Future Finance Committee Meetings

The Board directed the administration to provide more information on the fee schedule at the next Finance Committee meeting.

Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at 7:33 pm with a motion by Ms. Ahlmann and a second by Ms. Foster.
