Below are the response rates:</p> <p>Slide 4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Admin 24-25 Survey 21 responses out of the 24 administrators sent surveys <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Note: The change in response rate was mostly at the elementary level. Responses from Early Childhood, Middle School, High School, and Adult Learning had the almost the exact same response rate from 24-25 to 25-26. The change in total responses filled out was dramatically concentrated at the elementary level with all 8 principals filling it out during the 24-25 school year and only 4 elementary principals during the 25-26 school year. • Admin 25-26 Survey 17 responses out of the 24 administrators sent surveys <p>Slide 6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 71 staff members on the licensed professional staff rubric completed the survey out of a total of 126 staff <p>Both of these have been added/updated in the board presentation slides.</p>
