TITLE: Approval of Intergovernmental Agreement with Paradise Valley Unified School District Regarding Live Experiential Learning Programs

BACKGROUND:

Paradise Valley School District has invited the District to enter into an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) to permit district students to participate in its Live Experiential Learning Programs. The programs are offered in four or six-week segments in the Fall and Spring. The first program, to be offered this Fall, is to teach first graders the science and technology behind ice cream: from the cow to their mouths.

Each Live Experiential Learning Program requires participating teachers, staff or district representatives to view online teacher professional development, and the district to provide all equipment for the district's students to view live-feed broadcasts.

Costs associated with student participation include:

- 4 week program: \$2 (two dollars) per participating student;
 \$250 (two-hundred fifty dollars) per classroom kit; or
 \$30 (thirty dollars) per classroom program curriculum.
- 6 week program: \$3 (three dollars) per participating student;
 \$300 (three-hundred dollars) per classroom kit; or
 \$50 (fifty dollars) per classroom program curriculum.

If approved, this Intergovernmental Agreement will commence with the school year and remain in effect until June 30, 2020. Counsel has reviewed the agreement and has determined that it is within the power and authority of the Amphitheater Governing Board to enter into this IGA, attached hereto for the Board's review.

RECOMMENDATION:

This item is presented for the Board's action. The administration recommends approval of this IGA.
