Background Information

Advising Generation Z is an online, alternative disciplinary resource that provides engaging digital diversion videos, matching lessons, and facilitation guides that can be used to address specific student infractions independently or in a group setting. The online platform provides campuses with ready-made modules that target specific behaviors, proving to be an essential part of Duncanville ISD's overall behavior management program.

Administrative Considerations

This partnership was provided to Duncanville ISD at no cost during the 2024–2025 school year. The platform was successfully piloted in middle school In-School Suspension (ISS) classrooms and both alternative campuses, resulting in significant reductions in Out-of-School Suspension (OSS) placements.

Based on the positive outcomes, Duncanville ISD was awarded an **\$8,000 scholarship** to continue the partnership during the **2025–2026 school year**, reducing the district's financial responsibility to **\$12,000**.

For the **2026–2027 school year**, Duncanville ISD was awarded an additional **\$6,000 scholarship** to continue the partnership, reducing the district's cost to **\$6,000**.

The continued scholarship support reflects the program's demonstrated impact and provides the district with a cost-effective opportunity to sustain an initiative that has contributed to improved student behavior and reduced exclusionary discipline practices.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board approve the Memorandum of Understanding between Duncanville ISD and Advising GenZ to continue the partnership for the 2026-2027 school year.
