No Child Left Inside (NCLI) Grant Program: The MN Dept. of Natural Resources is excited to announce that we are now accepting applications for the 2024 grant round of the Applications must be received by 2:00 p.m. CST, Tuesday, December 12, 2023. Please [visit our website](#) to learn more.

The 2024 grants will consist of two types of grant awards. Applicants must choose only one.

- **Mini Grants**, with awards between \$500-\$5,000, will include a simple application for projects with smaller scope. Demand is expected to be high. Eligible projects will be entered into a lottery. Previous mini grant awardees are ineligible for additional mini grant funds.
- **Larger Grants**, with awards between \$5,001-\$25,000, will include a more extensive application process for greater project scope. Eligible projects will be competitively reviewed. Previous larger grant awardees are ineligible for any grant funds this phase.
