Subject: HB 3 Goal Progress Monitoring—GPM 3.1—Meeting CCMR Criteria
Date: June 10, 2026

HISTORY:

Student Outcome Goal 3 is a 5-year goal that is measured annually. It is related to the A-F Accountability System and the College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) point system. Prior to graduation, each senior is expected to earn one CCMR point via at least 1 of 11 different ways offered in San Elizario ISD. The board has created a goal for this purpose:

Goal 3

SEISD will increase the percentage of College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) points earned annually by SEHS seniors from 30% in May 2023 to $\geq 88\%$ by June 2028 as measured by the A-F Accountability System.

To measure our progress toward this annual goal, we examine Goal Progress Measure (GPM) 3.1.

GPM 3.1

The percentage of SEHS seniors earning a CCMR point by meeting any of the CCMR criteria will increase from 52% in May 2025 to $\geq 64\%$ by June 2026, as measured by the OnData Suite CCMR Early Warning System along with an internal tracker used by the campus and CCMR specialist at the campus.

RATIONALE:

GPM 3.1 can be measured using the program OnData Suite and an internal campus tracker. This program provides CCMR data to help determine which students are not on track to earn a CCMR point prior to graduation. This data is used to target seniors who do not have a path to a CCMR point, so that we may intervene prior to graduation. Along with the OnData program, the campus uses their internal tracker to cross reference information and take appropriate action.

The CCMR indicator is a “lagging” indicator within the A-F Accountability System. This means it runs a year behind. Seniors from the class of 2025 will impact the 2026 accountability ratings.

This report provides the OnData Suite CCMR percentage for the 2025 seniors which will impact our upcoming accountability ratings. The percentage shows that **84% of the 2025** seniors have the CCMR point, or 215 out of 255 students. The target for 2025 was $\geq 52\%$, which is 32% above the CCMR secondary target according to the OnData Suite tracker.
