BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

ImageNet Consulting (1 Attachment)

- Term: N/A
- Cost: \$378,620.90
- Fund: Bond Construction

This service agreement is for the purchase, installation, configuration, and initial support of the hardware, software, and controls for the audio-visual presentation systems in the new Stillwater High School building. This is for all presentation spaces across the building including, but not limited to the gymnasium, large band room, student center, presentation rooms, and conference rooms.

United Systems (1 Attachment)

- Term: N/A
- Cost: \$52,242.48
- Fund: Bond Construction

This service agreement is for the purchase, configuration, and support of the Fortinet FortiVoice telephone system, including hardware, software, and licensing. This is a new system designed to replace our aging Mitel system at the new Stillwater High School building only. This new system will run concurrently with the current system until a future district-wide refresh is completed.

United Systems (1 Attachment)

- Term: NA
- Cost: \$263,530.22
- Fund: Bond Construction

This service agreement is for the purchase, installation, configuration and support of the Valcom Intercom system. This new intercom system will support building-wide communication, emergency notification, bell schedules, and clocks.

Orion Security Solutions (1 Attachment)

- Term: NA
- Cost: \$204,955.22
- Fund: Bond Construction

This service agreement is for the purchase, installation, configuration and initial support of the security camera and physical access control systems at the new Stillwater High School building. This solution will provide 71 total cameras and 13 badge accessible doors.
