



2026 Bus Use Proposal

Cherry Street Youth Center is requesting assistance with transportation services for the 2026 summer program. The summer program runs June 1st through July 23rd for middle schoolers and elementary students. We anticipate providing summer programming to 60 elementary aged children and 20 middle school aged children Monday through Thursday in June & July.

Specific needs include transporting children from Cherry Street (710 N Forest Ave) to the Aquatic Center (400 S. Highland Ave.) and back to Cherry Street June 22nd-July 2nd for swim lessons. Pick up for swimming lessons would need to be 9:45 and we will be ready to leave the pool at 11:30. We also have a field trip planned to the Whitetails & Wildlife Museum in Humboldt KS on June 16th. We would plan to leave Cherry street (710 N Forest Ave) at 9:00 a.m. and load the bus to return to Chanute at 11:00 a.m. from the Museum (715 New York St, Humboldt KS).

We have greatly appreciated the support of USD 413 in the past. Our goal with the summer program is to ensure the participating children receive a nutritious breakfast and lunch, have the opportunity to continue academic growth, and to offer fun learning opportunities.
