The Installation Additions Invoice shall reflect any credits for compensation or payments, previously received by TAVL. Customer agrees to make full and final payment five (5) business days upon receiving Installation Additions Invoice. Failure to make full payment by due date on Installation Additions Invoice shall incur a FIFTEEN PERCENT (15%) surcharge on the total amount due.

V. CREDIT CARD PAYMENT POLICY: For credit card payments made via an on-line payment system, email or over the telephone, a FIVE PERCENT (5%) convenience fee will be added to the final invoiced amount.

VI. FORCE MAJUERE ("ACT OF GOD") PROVISIONS: TAVL is not responsible for any events beyond their control that prevents TAVL from complying with any of its obligations under this Agreement, including but not limited to acts of God (including but not limited to fires, explosions, earthquakes, pandemics, drought, tornadoes, excessive wind and/or rain, floods) as well as an act of government, power shortage, blackouts, failure of telephone and internet services, accident, acts of public enemy, war, rebellion, labor dispute or unrest, insurrection, sabotage, transportation delays (other than administrative oversights), shortage of raw materials, energy or machinery. If and to the extent that TAVL is prevented from executing the services described herein then TAVL shall be relieved of its obligations to provide the services but shall endeavor to continue to perform its obligations under the Agreement so far as reasonably practical, and in accordance with industry-standard operating practices, provided that if and to the extent that TAVL incurs additional costs in so doing, TAVL shall be entitled to the amount of such costs (with no profit component). Customer acknowledges the risk of acts of God and accept the risks associated therewith in contracting with TAVL.

VII. MARKETING LICENSE: The Customer expressly grants to TAVL a license to use any photographs or video of the installation, build-out, or final production for purposes of TAVL marketing materials and website use.

VIII. POST INSTALLATION: TAVL is not responsible for equipment failure, technical issues, or defects in control caused solely by the acts or omissions of Customer's employees, agents, guests, or subcontractors; and Customer is responsible for the physical and working condition of the installed equipment at all times, and through operation and use by all employees, agents or subcontractors.

IX. INDEMNIFICATION: Customer agrees to indemnify and hold TAVL, their officers, agents, and employees harmless from any liability, loss, or damage they may suffer as a result of claims, demands, costs or judgments against them arising out of the activities to be carried out pursuant to the obligations of this Agreement.

X. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: Texas AVL and its consultants, partners, agents, and employees shall not be liable to the Customer for any and all claims, losses, expenses, injuries, or damages arising out of, or any way related to this Agreement by reason of act or omissions, including breach of this Agreement or negligence not amounting to a willful or intentional act for any amounts in excess of the total sum paid to TAVL under this Agreement. TAVL shall not be liable to the Customer for any special or consequential damages, including but not limited to, lost profits, loss of use, and costs of replacement, caused by TAVL's negligence, breach of this Agreement, or any other cause whatsoever.

XI. REVIEW AND CONSULTATION: It is understood and agreed that Customer has entered into and executed this Agreement voluntarily and that such execution by Customer is not based upon any representations or promises of any kind made by TAVL or any of its representatives except as expressly recited in this Agreement. Customer further acknowledges that it has read and fully understands each section of this Agreement and that it was afforded the opportunity to consult with an attorney prior to executing this Agreement.

Payment is due upon receipt unless noted on your invoice. All past due balances will be assessed 1.5% per month. Texas AVL, LLC reserves all lien, collection and other rights available under law enforceable in Bexar or Webb county, Texas. Payments may be made by cash, check or credit card. Checks should be mailed to the address on the top right of the invoice. Payments by credit card may be made by electronic link sent to you by our Texas AVL, LLC representative.

Installation Terms and Conditions Contract

I. ESTIMATE: Texas AVL (herein refer to as TAVL) will provide an estimate(Quote) of installation, labor, and service costs to the customer. The quote will be in writing. TAVL will use the customer's verbal description in addition to any schematic layouts and walkthroughs to approximate cost as closely as possible to the customer's desired layout; however, TAVL will not be responsible for any changes in design, product, color, or location after installation has begun. If customer requests changes to any or all portions of completed work, customer will be responsible for the original and changed installation costs. The quote provided to customer will be active for no more than a seven (7) day period after which a new quote may be required at the discretion of TAVL. TAVL will deliver a Quote to customer; for which the design layout and estimated cost must be approved via the customer's signature. Subsequent customer-requested additions and/or changes to the quote may result in increasing the final production cost. All labor charges are ESTIMATED only at the time of the quote. Actual labor charges are subject to change dependent on final confirmation of installation timeline.

II. CUSTOMERS RESPONSIBILITIES: Customer is required to provide TAVL with an initial install schematic or floor design on or before the approval of the quote, and a final schematic or floor design no later than ten (10) days prior to install date. Any changes to schematic or floor design after approval of the quote must be communicated to TAVL immediately to determine alignment with existing Quote. No later than ten (10) days prior to the install, customer is required to provide TAVL with a list of additional service providers (ex: additional vendors, etc.) expected to draw power from the venue to determine overall electrical capacity of the venue. TAVL will not be responsible for inadequate, faulty, or overloaded electrical sources at the venue; however, TAVL will work with the customer to ensure adequate performance in conformance with the approved quote.

- The customer is required to provide TAVL with adequate power for the scope of the Installation
- Customer must provide 24-hour security of equipment.
- Customer must provide a certificate of insurance showing general liability naming Texas AVL as additionally insured at least ten (10) days prior to the installation date.

III. PAYMENT AND CONFIRMATION: Customer will be invoiced immediately following customer's approval of the Quote. Customer is required to place a Deposit for the full total of all the listed equipment and supplies that are on the installation quote. All labor charges must be paid within THIRTY (30) days upon completion of installation. Failure to pay balance of invoice, by the final payment due date, will incur a FIFTEEN PERCENT (15%) late fee on the remaining balance of the installation invoice. Providing customer with a Quote does not guarantee equipment delivery date or installation start date. Customer acknowledges that all equipment and design availability is limited and as such ALL DEPOSITS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. Cancellations made less than seven (7) business days prior to the installation date will be invoiced in full. Certain in box used items may be may returned with a TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT (25%) restocking fee. In Addition, customer agrees to pay any and all legal fees incurred by TAVL in connection with any and all collection efforts necessary to obtain fees due by customer. Such fees are not limited to attorney fees and expenses, court costs and filing fees.

IV. INSTALLATIONS ADDITIONS INVOICE: Following conclusion of the installation, TAVL shall present to customer an Installation Additions Invoice, if applicable, inclusive of all additional, unpaid charges for rental, services or equipment used by Customer, including but not limited to fuel surcharges, damaged equipment surcharges, additional labor costs, added transportation costs, additional equipment needed, etc.

XII. GOVERNING LAW: This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, United States of America. Venue of any case or controversy arising under or pursuant to this Agreement shall be in Bexar, Texas, United States of America. Any prevailing party in an action related to this Agreement shall be entitled to recover their reasonable and necessary attorney fees.
