- Monitor alignment across campuses

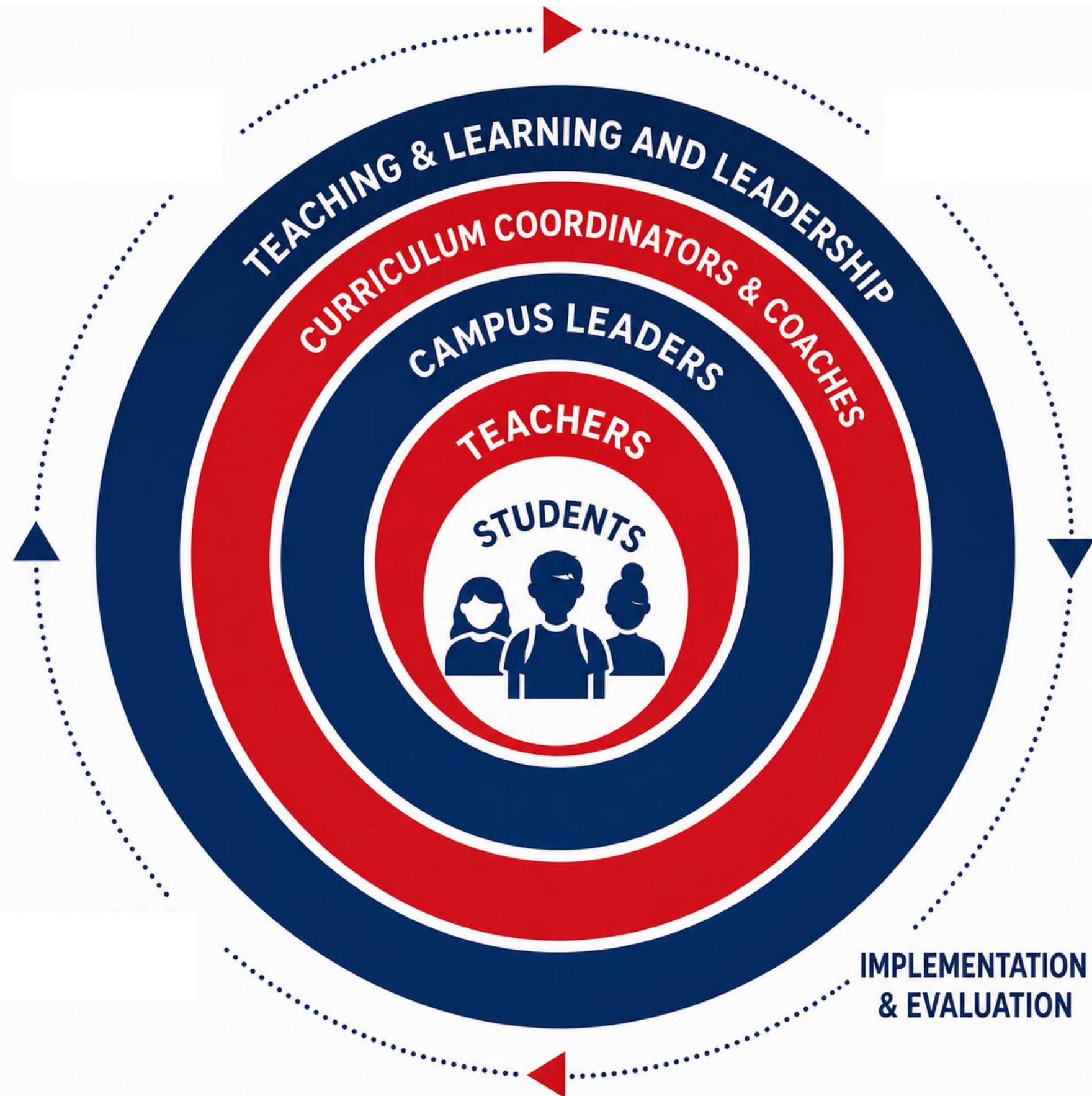

- Sharing best practices from high-performing campuses

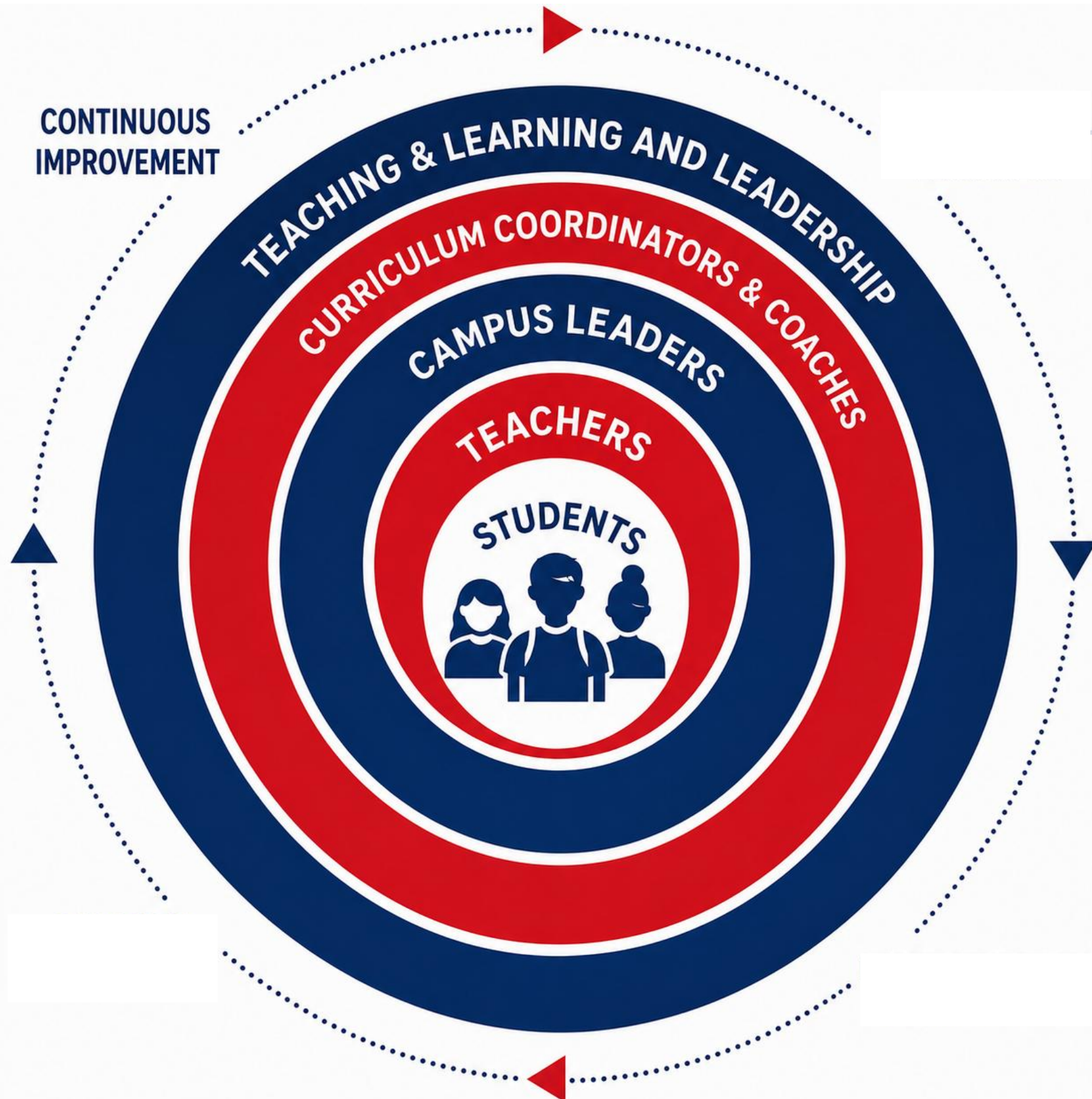
