Rationale:

The Lake County Regional Office of Education offers an Alternative Learning Opportunities Program, commonly referred to as ALOP, for eligible students in grades 4–12 who are at risk of academic failure and may benefit from an alternative educational setting.

The program provides a flexible, standards-based learning environment that includes individualized instruction, social-emotional supports, health and support services, and the development of a Student Success Plan for each participating student. Student placement requires District screening, parent or guardian consent, an intake meeting, and an administrative transfer to the program.

Under the agreement, the District remains responsible for student transportation, permanent student records, and any required special education, Section 504, English learner, or related services. The Lake County Regional Office of Education is responsible for providing the instructional program, monitoring student progress, communicating with families and the District, and maintaining temporary student records during the student's participation.

The agreement is intended to provide the District with an additional educational placement option for students whose academic, social-emotional, attendance, or behavioral needs may not be adequately addressed through the District's traditional educational programs.

Financial Impact

The District will be responsible for transportation costs for any student placed in the program. The agreement does not identify an additional tuition charge to the District for the 2026–2027 school year.
