

**Consider approval of Instructional Materials Allotment TEKS Certification**  
**March 23, 2026**

1. Background:

School districts and charter schools are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education and the commissioner that, for each subject in the required curriculum other than physical education, students have access to instructional materials that cover all the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). Districts and charters will be unable to order 2025-2026 instructional materials through EMAT until the certification has been received by the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

2. Process:

[UCISD's Instructional Materials adoption process includes only those materials that meet the requirements for TEKS certification.](#) ([linked](#) to view resources by grade level and subject) All subject areas and all grade levels meet the TEKS standards. The TEKS Certification has been made digital this year. Upon board approval, we will submit to TEA, which will then allow us to be eligible to order 26-27 instructional materials through EMAT upon its opening in April for those requests.

3. Fiscal Impact:

Instructional materials ordered through the EMAT system are paid for with our Instructional Materials Allotment.
